AMOUNT: Four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. One student will be chosen from each high school: Bothell High, Inglemoor High, Secondary Academy for Success/ Northshore Networks, and Woodinville High.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must be a 2013-14 graduate from one of the Northshore School District high schools. The scholarship must be used at an accredited two or four year university, college, vocational, or trade school during the 2014-15 academic year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete Scholarship Application including responses to questions 1-9.
- Include two letters of recommendation, *one of which **must** be written by a staff member for a community/volunteer service organization.* No letters from relatives.
- Include a current copy of your high school transcript (should include as much 12th grade detail as possible.)
- **Postmark by Tuesday, March 18, 2014**
