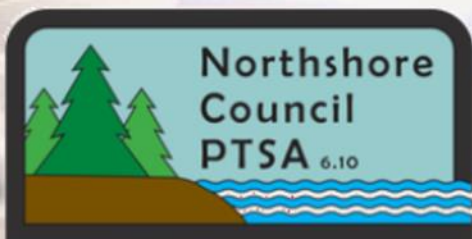


Emergency Preparedness

Thanks to their generosity, we have the beginnings of a family emergency kit for a local family: YETI (40% off of a Tundra cooler like the ones donated to Texas Hurricane Relief), SAFEWAY (6 Gallons of water, Purell, First Aid Kit and baby wipes), COSTCO (\$50 GC), ZULU'S BOARD GAME CAFE (\$25 GC for a family board game), COAST PORTLAND (an HP7 LED flashlight and a micro multi-tool), GRAYL (an Ultralight water purifier and an extra cartridge), C. CRANE RADIOS (CC Solar Observer AM/FM Weather Radio that can be powered via a built-in solar panel, batteries, the included wind-up dynamo or an AC adaptor), FIRST ALERT (4 compact design CO detectors), MOUNTAIN HOUSE Food (30% discount), our local EMERGENCY MANAGER (numerous Datrex water packs, twelve Surepak MREs and six yummy Datrex emergency ration packs) and an anonymous family (an emergency high-vis vest) all donated to an Emergency Preparation auction basket to raise money for our local school and Emergency Preparedness awareness.
